COVID Plan

Teams will be allowed to return to the team center if Mexico is orange level or less, governments allow for teams crossing the borders, and teams agree to and sign the new waiver and procedures. Team members are required to bring masks and requested to bring masks, hand sanitizer, and other PPE they deem necessary. Team size will be limited to 24 people.

- 1. Team members will test for COVID 3-5 days before the trip. They will make attempts to quarantine before their trip.
- 2. Team members will follow airline guidelines and if driving will make every attempt to limit exposure as they travel.
- 3. If a team member has taken both immunizations and is 10 days past their second dose they will not need to test. They will however need to show proof of the immunization.
- 4. All team members, tested and immunized, will need to follow all Missions Ministries procedures while part of the team in El Paso and Juarez.
- 5. Travel in vans will be limited to 6-7 people, preferably families together in a vehicle. This will include all travel, to the team center, around the colonias, and returning to El Paso.
- 6. Teams (families or individuals) will utilize every other room at the team center to improve spacing.
- 7. Team members will wear a mask any time that they are out of their rooms. Exceptions are eating and drinking. This includes at the jobsite.
- 8. In the cafeteria team members will space out the line, sit only at designated seating or may choose to sit outside in the pavilion.
- 9. Outreach (food, orphanage, church, prayer walk) will be modified to limit person to person contact and exposure to the general public.
- 10. Temperatures of each team member will be taken daily at the team center. If a team member's temperature is elevated, they will be given a separate room, be quarantined, and rechecked the next day. Meals will be delivered to their room as well as other items as necessary.
